You were starting to explore your world, express yourself, and become more comfortable in your own skin. You took part in extracurricular programs that you cared about and had confidence in a future for yourself, you maybe even dreamt of a career.

Being a young person born with a severe physical disability can be completely different.

You may not have the same confidence to explore your emotional and creative needs like your peers. You may be impacted by the physical and financial barriers just to get around while feeling socially isolated.

Because you have to rely on others to help you through the day-to-day, you haven't had the same quality of independence as others your age.

It might even be too foreign to imagine a future without the day-to-day struggles.

After a traumatic experience you suffer a debilitating spinal cord injury. You spend weeks, months, even years in recovery and rehabilitative therapy. Endless strenuous appointments far from home and familiar spaces consume your calendar now.

The complexities you are facing while developing your identity, is now complicated with trying to understand how to navigate life as a person with a severe physical disability.

You are now tackling barriers that never existed before. Something as simple as transportation that used to be as easy as hoping in a car or calling an Uber now monopolize your thoughts.

Watching you friends and family continue to go about their routine as before, and you can't imagine how you will adjust to your injury.

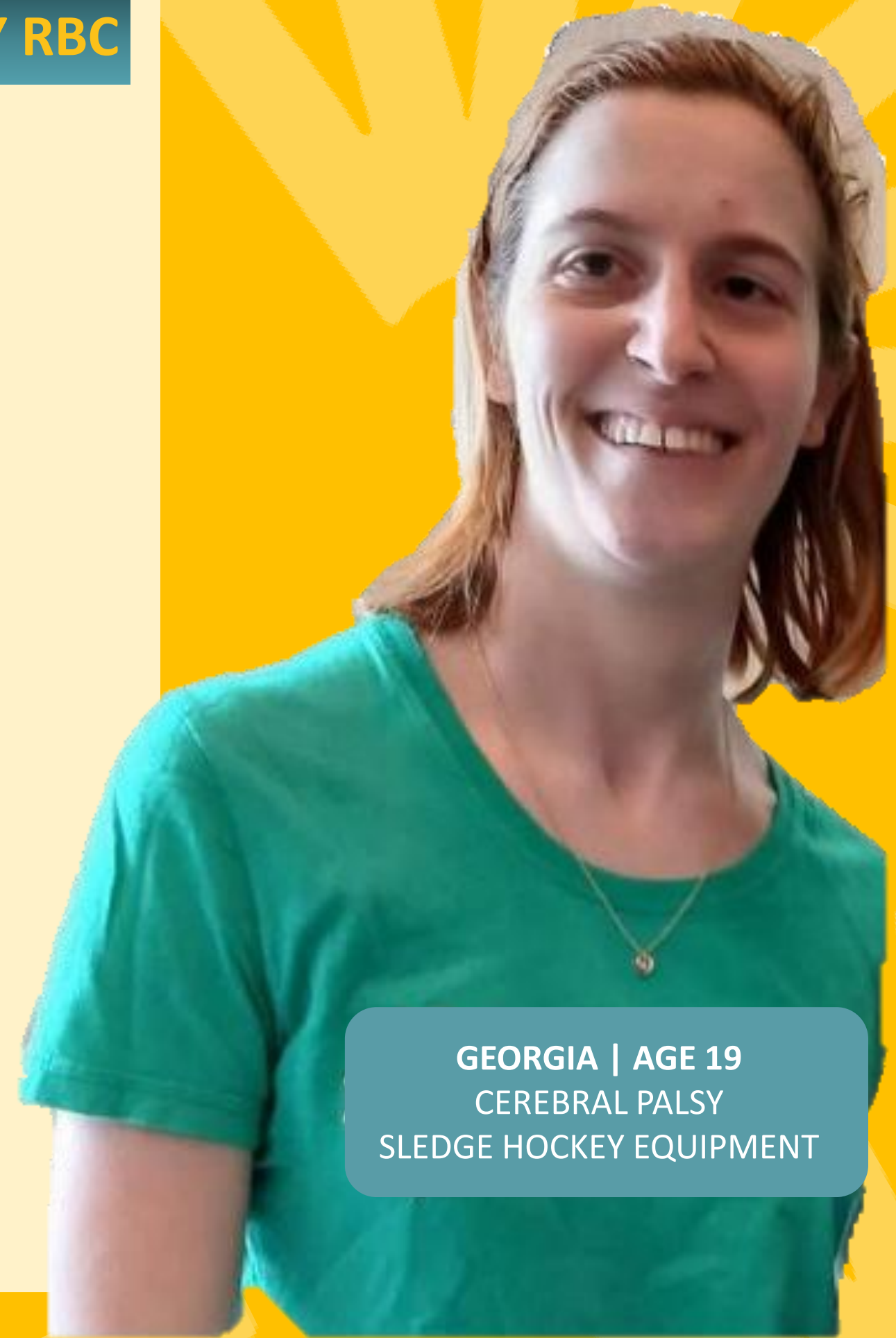

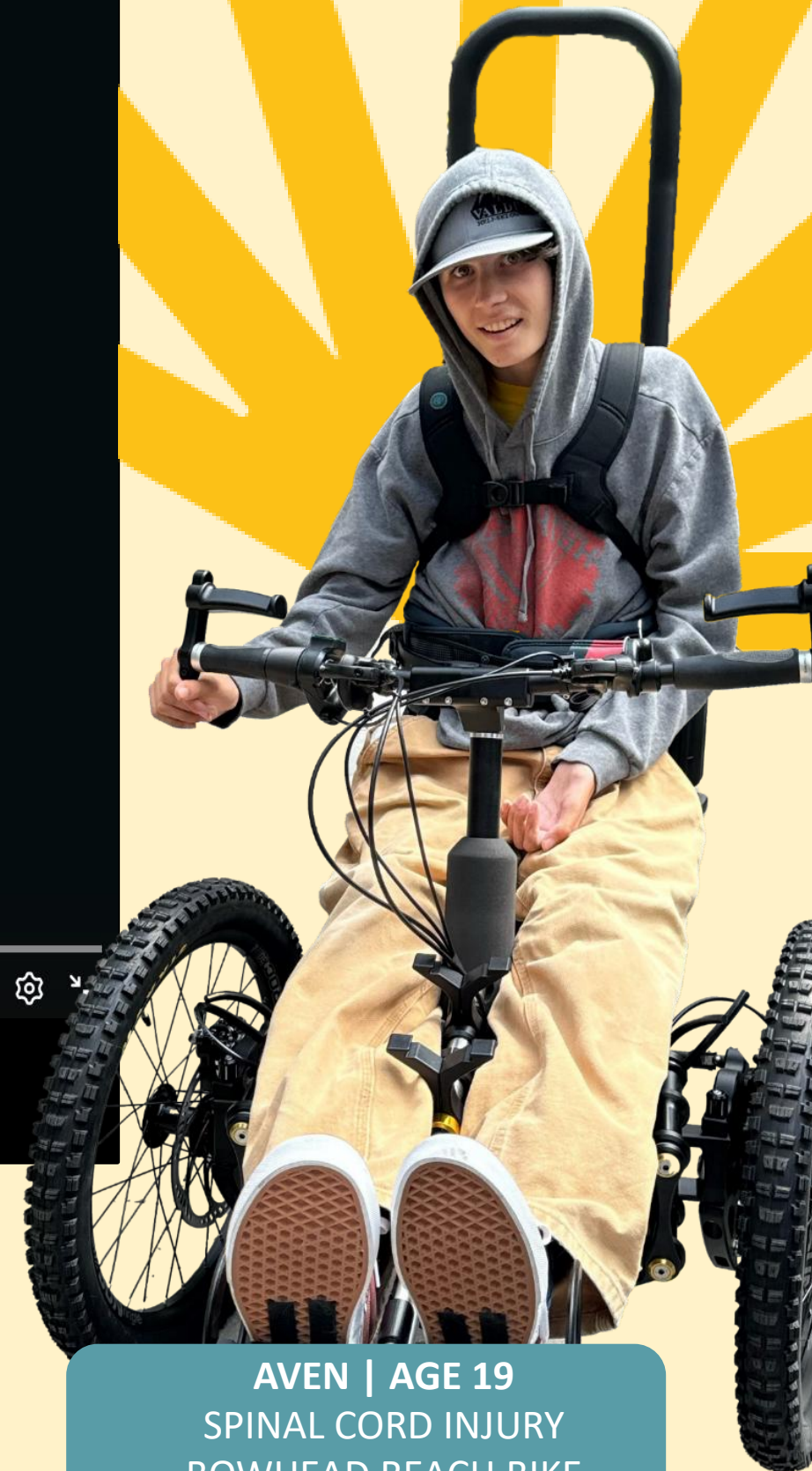
